UPCOMING LECTURE - September 21, 2018 "Competency and Confidence in Leadership, Wisdom from a 41-year Career in Service"

In this distinctive keynote, Lloyd J. Austin III, General, U.S. Army (Retired), who oversaw the U.S. military presence in 20 countries in the Middle East, Central Asia, and Southeast Asia, will share global insights into his values-based leadership philosophy including teamwork and the importance of respecting all people.

General Austin was appointed by President Barack Obama as the 12th Commander of United States Central Command (CENTCOM). Austin is the first African American to head the organization. Prior to current assignment, Austin served as the 33rd Vice Chief of Staff of the United States Army. For the past two years, General Austin has served as West Point's Class of 1951 Leadership Chair for the Study of Leadership. General Austin has received, among other recognitions, the Defense Distinguished Service Medal, the Army Distinguished Service Medal, the Defense Superior Service Medal, and the Legion of Merit. Currently, General Austin serves on the Board of Directors of three publicly-traded companies: Tenet Healthcare, United Technologies and Nucor Corporation.
