Mrs. Hesselbein was awarded the Presidential Medal of Freedom, by President Clinton in 1998 for her leadership as CEO of the Girl Scouts of the USA, as well as her service as "a pioneer for women, volunteerism, diversity and opportunity." From 2009-2011 she served as the Class of 1951 Chair for the Study of Leadership at the United States Military Academy at West Point. Also in 2009, the University of Pittsburgh introduced The Hesselbein Global Academy for Student Leadership and Civic Engagement, which is an annual leadership Summit that annually trains 50 student-leaders. Mrs. Hesselbein is the recipient of 21 honorary doctoral degrees. She is the co-editor of twenty-eight books in twenty-nine languages and the author of three autobiographies. She has traveled to 68 countries representing the United States. In 2015, Hesselbein was ranked one of the World's 50 Greatest Leaders by Fortune Magazine.

"TO SERVE IS TO LIVE"

Frances defines leadership as "Leadership is a matter of how to be, not how to do." She attests that we spend most of our lives learning how to do and teaching other people how to do; yet in the end, she believes it is the quality and the character of the leader that determines the performance, the results. Frances spends 1/3 of her time on university campuses, 1/3 with corporations, and 1/3 with social sector organizations. Frances believes, "To serve is to live."
