

Influenced deeply by leadership expert Frances Hesselbein, Dr. Diane Ryan is focused on character-based leadership at all levels, in all sectors. Dr. Ryan will explore values-based leadership development as well as share research that demonstrates the importance of quality, character, mind-set, values and principles in today's rapidly evolving world.

Diane M. Ryan is the Associate Dean for Programs and Administration in the Jonathan M. Tisch College of Civic Life at Tufts University. As the only university-wide initiative of its kind, Tisch College prepares students for a lifetime of engagement in civic life, to study civic life and its intersections with public and private institutions, and to promote practices that strengthen civic life in the U.S. and around the world. Prior to joining Tufts, Diane was an Academy Professor, Director of the Eisenhower Leader Development Program with Columbia University and Acting Deputy Department Head in the Department of Behavioral Sciences and Leadership at the U.S. Military Academy, West Point, NY. During her 29 year career as a U.S. Army officer she served in a variety of assignments both stateside and abroad. Diane is a noted expert in leader development and mentoring and holds a B.A. in Psychology from the College of the Holy Cross, an M.S. in International Relations from Troy University, an M.S.S. in Strategic Studies from the United States Army War College and a Ph.D. in Psychology from North Carolina State University.
